Certification and Re-Certification

- This program certifies individuals aged 14-18 to officiate lacrosse games, with a recommendation to officiate youth games at least two age levels below their own.
 - Cost: \$35 Includes: Teaching materials, Classroom session, Field sessions

Annual Certification/Re-Certification Requirements:

Requirement	Details	Frequency
Attend a Training Clinic	Classroom and on-field instruction.	Annually
Pass the Annual Online Rules Exam	Online Rules Exam	Annually
Demonstrate Required Officiating Skills	Via an On-Field Evaluation.	Annually
Be a Current USA Lacrosse Member (Official Participation)	Contact Member Services to add "Official" if <u>currently</u> a player member.	Annually
Complete the <u>Rules</u> On-Line Course	Approximately 2 hours; one-time requirement in addition to the Training Clinic.	Once
Watch the Annual Professional Development Course	May occur during the classroom session or at home.	Annually

- Failure to receive notification indicates incomplete requirements and non-certification.
