PENALTY CARD REMINDERS

- Yellow Cards: the penalty time for a yellow card will be 2 minutes for all levels.
- Two Yellow Cards: Any player receiving two yellow cards in any given game will NOT be allowed to play the remainder of that game, but she will be allowed to play in the next game.
- Red Cards: the penalty time for a red card will be 4 minutes for all levels. The player receiving the red card is out the remainder of the game in which it occurred as well as the next full game.

CONDUCT

Poor sportsmanship, taunting, trash talking, fighting or other unbecoming behavior on the part of players, coaches, parents or spectators will not be tolerated.

Unsportsmanlike conduct will minimally result in a yellow card, but officials are authorized to handle such conduct in their reasonable judgment based on the circumstances, including ending the game (which will be treated as a forfeit by each team regardless of "who did what"). Poor sportsmanship may also result in a red card; ejection from the game or the facility.

Only head coaches or team captains are permitted to address the officials; coaches are expected to do so in a courteous manner. Adults involved with the game are not permitted to openly or maliciously criticize, badger, harass, or threaten an official. Derogatory comments are unacceptable and subject to discipline, including ejection.

Officials are expected to conduct themselves as professionals and in a manner that demonstrates courtesy and fairness to all parties while exercising their authority on the field.

Head coaches may report any issues regarding officials and/or other teams to field marshals, Tournament directors or their representatives at Tournament headquarters. The tournament representative will use its reasonable efforts to address any concerns.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Players, coaches and spectators are expected to act in the nature of good sportsmanship at all times. Abuse of the referees will not be tolerated and is grounds for immediate removal from the tournament and facility. Any instance of such conduct will disqualify the responsible team from the tournament! **Remember, this is supposed to be a day of fun competition, please allow the kids to play, the coaches to coach, and the referees ref.**
